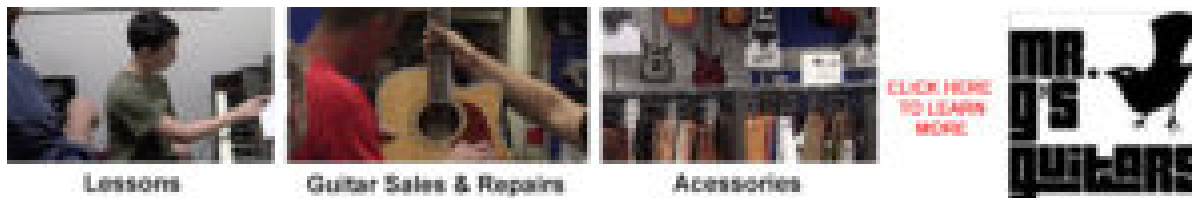

Premium Content Pearland vs South Houston

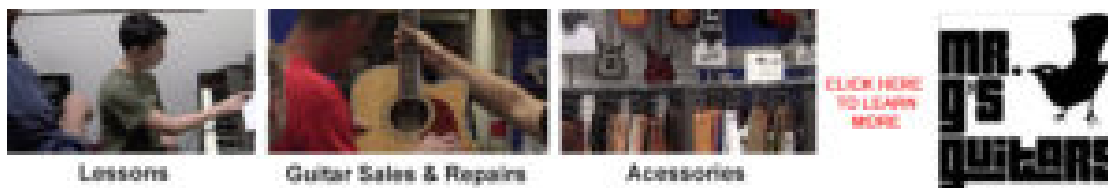

Defensively, Dawson never showed a weak quarter. Jada Rogers with three steals and two blocks

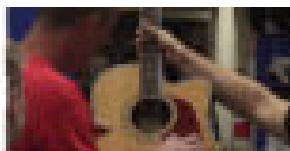

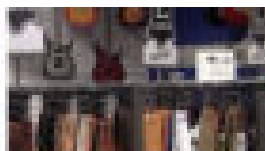

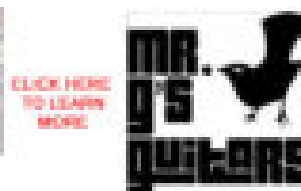

Premium Content Lady Oilers vs Clear Falls


